The Club transfers club funds to the 'working' account and the Council reimburses the club (From Grant Funding held by the Council) when the working account is exhausted. It was decided to engage Synergy Trails to rough-in remaining trails at a cost of approx. \$20k per month.

My Community Project Grant – is in and actively being voted on by the community – HMBA is requesting funds for 6 X Adaptive bikes and Training camps.

Next SCCF funding round closes in September – members are focusing on Youth Engagement – Pump Track, Jump Line, Skills Park, Junior committee, Junior Build Days
